

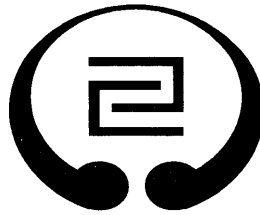

The Fee structure for the Gasshuku is listed below:

Juniors (Under 16 years of age) = AUD\$50.00 – two days training

Seniors (Kyu and Dan grades) = AUD\$120.00 – two days training
